ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon Plaintiffs MICHAEL GRANT and ARTHUR GRANT's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records, and the Court having reviewed said motion, file, and being otherwise fully advised on the premises, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- The Plaintiffs' Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is hereby GRANTED.
- This Order is being entered in case in which Plaintiffs are petitioning to remove the Defendant as Trustee of the GRANT LIVING TRUST U/T/D 8/18/2004 ("Grant Living Trust").
- 3. The Court finds that the Grant Living Trust inherently includes several private matters pertaining to the assets of the Grant Living Trust, the disposition of said assets to its intended beneficiaries, and all necessary details outlining the function of

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the Grant Living Trust. The Grant Living Trust is protected by the privacy rights of the Plaintiffs and the financial and organizational details of the Grant Living Trust are not inherent to the case that is being pursued by the Plaintiffs. See Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. Rule 2.420(c)(9)(a)(vi).

- 4. This Court determines the Grant Living Trust to be confidential in order to comply with public policy set forth in Florida Statutes and case law. See Fla. R. Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin. Rule 2.420(c)(9)(a)(vii). See Borck v. Borck, 906 So. 2d 1209, 1211 (Fla 4th DCA 2005)(citing Friedman v. Heart Inst. of Port St. Lucie, Inc., 863 So. 2d 189 (Fla. 2003); Mogul v. Mogul, 730 So. 2d 1287, 1290 (Fla. 5th DCA 1999).
- 5. The parties' names are not made confidential by this Order.
- 6. The progress docket or similar records generated to document activity in this case are not to be made confidential.
- 7. Pursuant to Rule 2.420 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, Exhibit A of the Petition to Remove Trustee (Grant Living Trust) is a confidential document and shall be sealed by the Clerk, absent further Order of this Court.
- 8. The named Plaintiffs and Defendants or the Counsel of Record for either party are the only individuals who are permitted to view the confidential Court records, absent further order of this Court.
- 9. This court finds the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court is no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration Rule 2.420(c)(9)(a)(vi)-(vii) and there

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are no less restrictive measures available to protect the interests set forth in the aforementioned Rules.

10. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to publish the order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(5) of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration.
